Description

It is Jesus who once won the fight and Satan's power defeated. And still he puts the foe to flight and takes from Satan every right, our living glorious champion. Hallelujah! Hallelujah! Hallelujah! Have we ever called upon Jesus as the redeemer, victor, and prince of victory over our sinful bondages, our fear, or our problems, even if for only ten minutes? I want to do this so that I'll be full of inner strength and can overcome and be at peace when the hour of great temptation comes over the earth. I want to do this so that I'll inherit the crown of eternal life.

Therefore, come to Him. Come to the living Lord and claim His victory. Then your life will be filled with victory and joy.
