Description

Chuck Smith emphasizes the critical role of faith in salvation, asserting that without faith, it is impossible to please God. He challenges believers to examine their faith, noting that many trust in human means rather than divine promises, and questions whether they have enough faith for both small and significant matters. Smith highlights that true faith must manifest in actions, as demonstrated in the book of James, and calls for believers to seek an increase in their faith through the Word of God. Ultimately, he urges the congregation to reflect on the question, 'Where is your faith?'
