Description

He argues that claiming to love God while harboring hatred or fear towards others is hypocritical, as perfect love drives out fear. Wilkerson reminds us that God's command is to love one another as He loves us, highlighting that love must be genuine and inclusive. The sermon challenges listeners to reflect on their relationships and the authenticity of their love for God in light of their love for others.

Transcript

If someone says, 'I love God,' and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen? And this commandment we have from Him: that he who loves God must love his brother also" (1 John 4:20-21)
