In prayer, we should beware of limiting God by unbelief and instead expect great and unexpected things.

Scripture: John 11:21

Topics: "Prayer", "Expectation in God"

Description

D.L. Moody emphasizes the importance of not limiting God in our prayers, as demonstrated in the conversation between Martha and Jesus regarding the resurrection of her brother. He encourages believers to approach prayer with a heart of worship and to expect God to do unexpected things beyond our understanding. By recognizing God's glory and our position in Christ, we can open ourselves to the vast possibilities of His power and grace. Moody reminds us that our faith should not be constrained by our own beliefs or expectations.

Transcript

Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord...I know that...whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee. Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again. Martha saith unto Him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day. --John 11:21-24

Beware, in your prayer, above everything, of limiting God, not only by unbelief, but by fancying that you know what He can do. Expect unexpected things, above all that we ask or think. Each time you intercede, be quiet first and worship God in His glory. Think of what He can do, of how He delights to hear Christ, of your place in Christ; and expect great things. --Andrew Murray
