Fox encourages believers to walk in the mighty power of God, akin to valiant warriors empowered by the strength of the living God who is always present with them.

. . . I DO Charge you all in the Presence of the Living God, to dwell in what ye speak and profess; and none to profess, what he doth not dwell in; and none to profess, what he is not; a Sayer, and not a Doer; such beget vain Talkers. . . . All Friends, dwell in the Light, which is Eternal, which comprehends the World, that with it ye may comprehend the World; and rise up, and go on in the mighty Power of God, as mighty Men of War in the Power and Strength of the mighty God of Life . . . who is with you. . . .
