Ultimately, he highlights the significance of pure refreshings that come from living in harmony with God's love.

## Transcript

. . . Mind the Light, that all may be refreshed in one another, and all in one. And the God of Power and Love keep all Friends in Power, in Love, that there be no Surmisings, but pure Refreshings in the unlimited Love of God, which makes one another known in the Conscience, to read one another's Hearts: being comprehended into this Love, it is Inseparable, and all are here one. And keep in the Oneness . . . that one pure Faith may be held in all, to guide and preserve all in the Unity of the Spirit and Bond of Peace; all one family of Love, Children of one Father and of the Houshold of God.
