

Nehemiah 6 - Part 7

Duration: 6:16

Scripture: Psalm 25:4-5, Psalm 127:1, Proverbs 19:21, Isaiah 9:6, Isaiah 44:5

Topics: "Holy Spirit", "Sanctification"

Description

This sermon emphasizes the importance of seeking the stamp and work of God in our lives, rather than relying on human efforts or worldly counsel. It calls for surrendering to the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit and allowing the seal of the resurrected Savior to be upon us. The speaker acknowledges the need for divine guidance, the counsel of the Almighty, and the conquering power of God to overcome worldly temptations and build God's kingdom instead of our own.

Transcript
