Description

Transcript

You know, sometimes you just gotta get through the crowd to the hem of the Lord's garment. And I don't know what that looks like for you tonight, but it looks different than the norm, I'll just say that. It just takes a couple of you to break through and pull on Jesus.

Just everyone begin singing in the spirit all over the room. Come on, worship team, court, you play your instrument. Emma, want the team to just prophesy with their instrument, sing in the spirit.

Come on, lift your voice, church, lift your voice. Come on, lift your voice, sing in the spirit, sing in the spirit. Keep worshipping the Lord.

I want everyone in the house tonight to forget about everybody here, to forget about our worship team, forget about me. Let this place become your prayer closet tonight. Just forget about everything, everything.

Forget about the person to your right, to your left. Forget about Jesus' image and look to Jesus himself. If you need to get out of the aisle or out of your seat, if you need to get down on your knees, if you need to get on your face, just refuse the ordinary tonight.

Refuse the ordinary, be flammable tonight. Brian, get Jones. Keep blessing the Lord, don't stop, don't stop.

You'll hit a gear in the spirit, you'll hit a gear and the Lord will just take over. Pick this girl up for me, you and Brian. Gently, gently, yep.

Thanks, Lord, for the fresh and fruitful of the Holy Ghost. Bring this girl here, bring her over here. Guys, don't watch me, just look at the Lord.

The Lord, send her back with fresh fire. Where are you from? Send her to Texas with fresh fire, fresh anointing. Keep singing in the spirit, the Lord's moving.

Be filled with the Holy Spirit. Keep blessing the Lord. Come on, let's have a Holy Ghost meeting tonight.

Joy unspeakable, filled with glory. Keep singing, keep singing. All you have to do is close your eyes, lift your hand and begin to love on the Lord, that's all you have to do.

fair you have to touch him in a different way you have to refuse the average stuff you gotta push it away to get through the crowd to the hem of this garment oh I want revival sure I don't believe you I'm not sure you know what you're asking for because he'll come in and uh murder every other desire you know most worship teams would yell at me for having them up there that long you see there's a price to it all he'll never remove your ability to desire him or not or not and if you don't look at him you'll never see him you gotta look first that's what happened to Moses he looked to see that bush that was burning but not consumed and then the bible says after he looked he saw we all want to see Jesus but the question is is he worth that second look yeah gracious more gracious than you

could ever imagine but he is not cheap he is not cheap and I am growing more and more disgusted with what is normal less and less connected to what 99.9% of pastors burn for who cares how many campuses we have who cares if he's not in the camp see there's a few people God wants to raise them up from this crowd tonight there's few people with the heart cry that Moses had if you don't go with us don't take us up from here few people just a few take the grace God has given them to get more of God typically God gives grace then we take that grace and use it for what we want or what we think he wants and don't take the time to ask him what he really wants John Kilpatrick said before the Lord poured out his spirit in Pensacola he said I don't want a new church I don't want a new ministry I

don't want a new sermon I don't want a new bible I want you I want you and I'm just not sure we know what we're asking for when we say that have you ever contemplated him him ever thought of him for so long that your heart burns I mean have you ever thought of him until you can't stop thinking about him see it's in this atmosphere where everything you've been praying for can happen in a second proximity proximity is everything that woman with the issue of blood spent all her money on doctors all her resources on trying to get well and then someone must have said something to her that sounded like this the man from Galilee Jesus the one we've been hearing about the one who's been healing the blind the one who we heard calm the storms that one who took those unlearned fishermen he just sent

them out two by two and it seems that they're doing the same thing this one who when he speaks he speaks as one having authority he's coming to our village Lydia you may have emptied your bank account but do you have one more request in your soul do you have the guts to fight through those who've been mocking you calling you unclean in all these years are you willing to walk out your door and press through their shameful looks to get to this one who raises the dead this one whom the weather obeys and there she came weak shameful unclean you know if I had to bet tonight there's people who've been in church all their life sitting next to someone who hasn't been in church very long sometimes it's the people who've been in church the longest who are the most stuck the most bound and she

pressed through those scornful looks and she saw a man walking a man of the likes she'd never seen before and the crowds thronged him pulled on him you see you can have an entire building singing the same song but not everyone sings the same way not everyone touches him the same way you know her scenario was life or death and I hate to tell you friends actually I'm happy to tell you so is ours without Jesus we die we die inside without Jesus this worship team is a bunch of performers without Jesus Joel's just playing a song just a bunch of performers without Jesus I'm just a performer myself she touched him differently she knew he could do what no other man could do there's something about Jesus this one who is filled with the power of the Holy Spirit that touch of faith that touch of

faith released virtue and that condition she spent everything on was gone in a moment what have you walked in with tonight emptiness sorrow sickness refuse the common and look to Jesus tonight look to Jesus tonight I can't articulate what God is doing in his people perfectly but you gotta refuse what most people settle for you gotta live for another age another day see sin is a satisfaction issue we are in a very special moment right now with the Lord but it's this touch that fills the soul him the mixture is such a trap such a trap church is built on personalities strategy alone copying people you may be able to copy what you see but you can't copy what you can't see you can't copy the presence of God as Bill would say I can't give you my history with God no there is an anointing that

tears down and builds back up and I'm telling you this God is doing that in his church pastors if you are listening to me throw your playbook out the window repent repent for being a slave to the opinions of people repent for believing that filled seats means success God filling the house is success repent this day and age of influence it's an idol I want to influence his heart and that's it I've been doing this for a long time now for a long time and I've peaked behind the curtain you see I've been in the green rooms that most of you would love to be in and sin is destroying people do you know why? they don't value moments like this they want to keep it moving my question is keep it moving to what? where do you want to go? what sounds more desirable? friend you may not have an issue of

physical blood but if you're bound in sin your heart is bleeding you don't have to be I've peaked behind the curtain as I told you the purity of Jesus is a rarity it's a rarity by numbers alone porn is probably running

rampant in this room lust the inability to control your eyes anger selfishness role playing this Christian thing which is really just hypocrisy your heart is bleeding and you've spent everything you know to spend to get free and it just hasn't worked you have issues in your family that you've just come to believe that will never go away because it's just always been that way your parents and grandparents and their parents if you'll touch Jesus tonight that issue of blood will dry up in you you say Michael I'm broken I'm really broken the people around me can't see it but I

am I'm broken I'm broken on the inside and I'm unclean I want you to lift your hand tonight just in this well this wonderful river just lift your hand and say Michael I'm broken I need Jesus the healer to heal my soul to heal me if you raised your hand or you wish you did you can't come forward because there's people I want you to get out of your seat in boldness as we are in the tangible presence of the Lord you just get out of the aisle right now get down there on your knees and don't care about anybody it is in moments like this that miracles happen and these are the greatest miracles let that bleeding heart get healed tonight maybe you're tired of being unclean just get right down there in the aisle the bible says though our sins be as scarlet he shall make us whiter than snow
