Oh, would you release my child from that demonic bondage? Lord, they're on a highway to hell. I need to fall at your feet and pray down heaven. Some of you parents need to get on your face before God and start contending for your families.

Stop clapping about it and do it. Find yourself here Sunday mornings. Find yourself here on Wednesdays and do business with God.

Business as usual is not going to cut it anymore.
