Scripture: Isaiah 40:3-5, Matthew 6:33, Matthew 7:13-14, Luke 3:4-6, John 1:23, Romans 8:17, Philippians 2:1-11

Topics: "Jesus Christ"

Description

In this sermon, the speaker explores the nature of the way of Christ. He poses questions about whether it is a broad or narrow way, an easy or difficult way, and a long or short way. The speaker suggests that the way of Christ is the path to eternal life and fullness of God's wisdom. He references Philippians 2 and Matthew 7 to support his points. The sermon also mentions the role of John the Baptist in preparing the way for the Lord Jesus.

Transcript

Let's turn to the book of Philippians. Philippians chapter 2. We'll read from verse 1. And we'll read through verse 11. Philippians 2 verse 1. Therefore, if there is any consolation in Christ, if there is any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, Fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, and one mind.

When found in the appearance as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. Therefore God also has highly exalted him, and given him the name which is above every name. That at the name of Jesus, every knee should bow, of those in heaven, of those on earth, and of those under the earth.

And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Let's have a word of prayer.
