Description

You just don't want to do that. Brothers, we need to be content. Bobby brought up that he felt like he was saying how profitable it was to think on that thought.

That we don't have to count it failure if we can't preach. Because God is sovereign. It's not failure.

Like I mentioned last time, failure is when I keep trying to preach and God hasn't called me to it. That's failure.
